The academic appointment for this position will be for an Assistant Teaching Professor of Speech/Accents, effective July 1, 2024 and instruction beginning September 2024 (Fall Quarter).

Significant experience with a variety of voice and speech pedagogies, phonetics, heightened text, as well as non-western methods of training would be welcome.
