Essential Functions/Typical Duties

- * Perform student-center instruction for courses in 3D Design, Sculpture, 2D Design and Drawing
- * Assess student learning outcomes using a variety of assessment methods that includes the principles of equity and access
- * Facilities management: oversee operation of all wood lab, metal shop and foundry facilities including purchasing equipment, tools and supplies, coordinating with Campus Operations for facilities maintenance
- * Contribute to departmental governance and participate in life and culture of the department, division and college, such as college-wide effort to dismantle barriers that can impact underrepresented and historically marginalized student populations
- * Participate in program activities, such as mentoring adjunct faculty, oversee technical staff and student employees
- * Provide culturally-responsible advising for students enrolled in the program, such as navigating obstacles that underrepresented and historically marginalized student populations may experience in college (e.g. students with disabilities, students of color, first generation college students, LBGTQia students, Veterans, 2nd language learners, etc.)
- * Foster a positive and caring, equitable learning environment where diversity and pluralism are advanced through maintaining skills in cultural versatility
- * Coordinate with Continuing Ed on use of 3D spaces
- * Maintain up to date knowledge and skills in teaching methods and Art discipline

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- * MFA from an accredited institution in Sculpture/ 3D Design or related terminal degree
- * A record of two years teaching successfully at college or university level
- * Experience in wood lab management
- * Experience working as a collaborative team player in a collegial department environment

- * Complete the Supplemental Questionnaire
- * Attach a Cover Letter that addresses how you meet Minimum and Preferred Qualifications (max 2 pgs)
- * Attach a Curriculum Vitae
- * Attach a statement of your Teaching Philosophy (max 1 pg)
- * Attach a Diversity Statement that addresses the following: Please provide specific examples of how your educational and/or professional experiences, background or philosophy demonstrate your commitment to diversity and equity, and how these prepare you to contribute to Bellevue College (minimum 300 words, maximum 325 words, 12 pt font, double-spaced). Please note that your Teaching Philosophy must be a separate response from your Diversity Statement.
- * Attach a digital portfolio of professional work, as well as samples of student work from your classes, containing no more than 20 pages (supported file types: doc, docx, pdf, jpeg, jpg). Ensure each image is of sufficient size and resolution for naked-eye viewing
- * Attach an example of course assignment you created, along with an assessment tool
- * Attach copy of academic transcripts (unofficial transcripts may be submitted - official transcripts required upon employment)
