Course outline:

This course refines and develops students' ability to communicate effectively in Vietnamese language in a range of professional contexts. The course will support students in mastering the formal conventions of various modes of professional communication that new graduates are likely to encounter, including employment applications and interviews, oral presentations, leading discussions, and professional writing for reports and other common forms of organisational communication. These practical skills will be presented within the broader context of reflection on key differences between Vietnamese and international workplace culture and practice.

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

Identify key differences between Vietnamese and international communication styles.  
Engage in various forms of written and oral communication in Vietnamese at a professional level.  
Express complex scholarly and technical concepts related to their core field of study in Vietnamese.
