- A statement outlining your teaching philosophy
- A statement outlining your current research

Letters of recommendation are not required at the time of application but will be requested at a later stage, if application is successful.

Academic transcripts are not required at the time of application, however certified transcripts are required before an offer of employment is made in accordance with the ACAD Faculty Association Collective Agreement.

Applications must be submitted in one single PDF document.
