The standard annual teaching load is five courses; however, release time or other compensation is associated with chairing the department. The College provides a generous sabbatical leave program and professional development support for both research and teaching.

This statement can be included in the cover letter or the teaching statement. In their cover letter, candidates should address their interest in working at a liberal arts college with undergraduates, majors as well as non-majors, at all levels of instruction.
