*Qualifications: *Terminal degree in Graphic Design, Advertising or other appropriate design discipline is required. Candidates must have two years of previous teaching experience at the college level or three years of professional business practice with expertise in contemporary technologies and social media. A proven record of award-winning professional work and/or academic scholarship is preferred.

Positions are ten-month, full-time, tenure-track assignments at the rank of Assistant Professor effective for the Fall 2022 semester, unless otherwise indicated. Teaching assignments and related responsibilities may include day, evening, weekend and online courses. Courses may be taught at the Union campus, Kean Ocean, Kean Skylands or other locations. Faculty positions located in the Nathan Weiss Graduate College may require evening hours for graduate course assignments.
