publications and successful grant applications, or clear potential thereof.

The appointee is expected to complement the Department's Ethnomusicology program, to strengthen research activities, and to actively apply for external grants. Duties include (a) conducting top-tier independent research; (b) teaching two courses per semester at undergraduate/postgraduate level; (c) supervising students' projects and postgraduate theses; and (d) assisting in administrative duties.

Appointment will normally be made on contract basis for up to three years initially commencing August 2022, which, subject to performance and mutual agreement, may lead to longer-term appointment or substantiation later.
