This role requires maintaining an active record of creative research and/or scholarship in interior design related areas, with a focus on how these explorations inform and shape the future of design education and the profession. Applicants will also be expected to contribute to advancing initiatives that align with the department's core value and mission of examining how design can contribute to a holistic approach to individual well-being.

Candidates will have the opportunity to teach design studios, seminars, and lecture courses for a diverse student body at the undergraduate and graduate levels and mentor graduate students.
