This is a term, non-tenure track appointment with the possibility of reappointment.

Position Requirements and Preferences:

The minimum educational credential required for the applicant is a master's degree in Communication, or a related field, with an emphasis on media production and broadcast. Candidates with a doctoral degree in Mass Communication or Communication with a focus on media production or broadcasting are preferred. A candidate with only a master's degree will be hired at the rank of lecturer. A candidate with a doctoral degree will be hired at the rank of Assistant Teaching professor. The degree must be completed by the time of application.

Full-time faculty normally teach four courses per semester. The successful candidate will have college teaching experience, media-industry production experience, and a commitment to university service and public outreach. Previous experience in advising and mentoring students is preferred. A familiarity with a wide range of media production practices and tools is required.
