degree in landscape architecture or an allied discipline. A doctoral degree and/or professional licensure are preferred, but not required. The school welcomes applicants with expertise in any aspect of landscape architecture, but preference will be given to those with expertise in design foundations, grading and stormwater management, building information modeling, or research. Candidates should have teaching experience and a clearly defined research agenda.
