The School of Architecture at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa (UH Manoa) invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position, at the Assistant Professor level, to begin in Fall 2025. Position duties include teaching at the graduate and undergraduate levels; research, professional practice, and/or creative work; and service. The School seeks a faculty member in architecture, who can teach and conduct research/professional practice in the following fields:

- (1) Teach studio courses in which students propose innovative architectural/urban designs for moderately complex buildings and sites. Draw upon professional practice experience with design development and construction document phases.
- (2) Ensure the compliance of the proposed design solutions with building and planning codes.
- (3) Teach studio courses in which students integrate building systems in architectural design

Minimum Qualifications:

- Candidates must have a minimum of a professional degree in architecture (BArch, MArch, DArch). If a candidate holds a BArch, a master's degree in architecture or related field is required.
- A professional license to practice architecture within the United States or in the countries that have reciprocity with NCARB.
- Five years minimum documented record of professional practice involved in all stages of design and construction administration.
