We are seeking a candidate who can exhibit experience in relationship-building with those they teach in order to promote growth and learning. Individuals with an ability to apply their professional experiences to a teaching setting with an active practice or history of a recent active practice are strongly desired.

The School of Drama at Carnegie Mellon University values candidates who exemplify a commitment towards building a more inclusive community which includes a vast array of identities and approaches to increased belonging who can utilize their experiences to increase the capacity of such practices. In addition to teaching, our faculty engage in other duties such as

Candidates should hold either a degree in dance or have equivalent professional experience and demonstrate a strong commitment to teaching excellence. This position requires someone to teach Horton and/or Graham Technique at various levels and have the ability to teach Ballet and/or Tap.
