The candidate will help cultivate and shape the interactive component of the graphic design program; advise and mentor undergraduate students; engage in service at the concentration, department, college, university and professional levels; disseminate

graphic design, interactive/web, and/or motion design is required. Candidates should be design practitioners with a record of recognition in the fields of graphic and interactive design, motion design and/or animation. Additionally, candidates should preferably have two or more years of college-level teaching experience, particularly in the fields of graphic and interactive design, app design, motion design, and animation.

Application Procedure

Required application materials:

- Letter of interest detailing qualifications
- Curriculum vitae
- A two-year plan of creative scholarship/research
- Statement of teaching and mentoring
- Copies of undergraduate and graduate transcripts (official transcripts required prior to employment)
- Digital portfolio (PDF, maximum file size is 2MB.)
- Contact information of three professional references (names, email addresses, and phone numbers)

Portfolio should consist of at least 10 examples of professional work in graphic and interactive design, as well as 10 examples of student work. All video, web and interactive work should be embedded in the PDF, or accessible through external links provided in the PDF.

Review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled. Applicants are encouraged to apply by October 18, 2024.
