The position is centered on design as a creative and solution-oriented sensemaking in which the act of giving form to physical and digital objects, relationships, and processes hold a central place. The position will also address the integration of formgiving with diverse layers of professional design practice, including strategic thinking, conceptions and representations of the end-users, design tools and processes, and contemporary production methods and technologies.
