The Department of Design is looking for a doctoral researcher with an interest to conduct research in the intersection between design integration and design education to support the development and research activities pursued through the Finnish Design Push initiative. Your role and goals

As a doctoral researcher, you will take part in studying the development and educational activities pursued through the initiative as well as conduct additional research studies within the broader realm of interest for the initiative. Advancing your doctoral studies and accompanying research studies form the foci of the position. However, as a doctoral researcher, you are also expected to contribute to teaching and take part in the administration and research activities for the initiative.

Design is frequently brought forward as pivotal for companies to stay competitive and innovative across many industries - being an integral part when developing offerings, deepening engagements with customers, and expanding into new markets. In critically examining the basic premises of such propositions, with the Finnish Design Push, we are interested in better understand the processes by which companies - and especially small- and medium-sized technology companies - becomes interested and acquires capabilities in design.
