The candidate will contribute to the research of the Department of Architecture within the research section History, Theory and Criticism, which unites researchers from both the Faculty of Engineering Science and the Faculty of Architecture. The Department offers an international research environment of excellence. Research at the Department on architectural history and theory of the modern period can boast a long and rich tradition that has gained international fame.

The candidate will contribute to the education of the Faculty of Engineering Science. The Faculty provides education at bachelor's, master's and advanced master's level.

You will develop an international research programme in the field of architectural history and theory for the period from the 19th century to the present with an emphasis on the 20th century after WWII. You use innovative research methods and pay attention to the interaction between architecture and the transformation of urban space.
