Primary responsibilities include designing costumes for three productions annually, teaching a course in costume design or a related topic and the daily operation, safety, and organization of the costume shop. The Theatre and Dance Department values inclusive, equitable and collaborative teaching, student-centered learning, and a production process in which everyone respects and values the abilities and creativity of all involved. Preferred qualifications: Master of Fine Arts degree in Costume Design or related field or a minimum three years of tested experience.
